Life Group Questions: To All Generations

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Read

Ephesians 3:20-21; Proverbs 22:6

Reflect

We all make plans for the future, or at least we know that we should. We know that we are supposed to save for retirement, to make good choices for our children, etc. But how many of us make plans to pass down our faith? Are we active in handing down our faith to the next generation? Paul in Ephesians 3:21 says that the Gospel is for all generations, forever.

Pastor Greg gave us three ways that we can pass on our faith to the next generation:

- We've got to catch it
 - We cannot pass down what we do not have. If someone came to you and asked you to pass down your faith to them, would you have anything to give? If you are a follower of Jesus, then the answer is yes! But we have to catch the Christian faith ourselves before we can pass it on.
- We've got to live it
 - But it doesn't stop at just catching it – we have to live it, to grow in the faith, to know Jesus better every single day. The reason is this: there is no better way to pass down the faith than by living it, out in the open, every day. When we live out the Gospel, we make others want to know what it is all about. What about you? Is your everyday life communicating the truths of the Gospel to those who see you?
- We've got to give it away
 - There is also more to passing our faith down than living it. We need to be intentional about mentoring young people, cheering them on and encouraging them to take our place.
 - Why do you think it is so hard for each generation to pass on their faith to the next one? What prevents us from giving the church away, to the next generation to take hold of?
