3. DETERMINE TO DO IT _____ WAY REGARDLESS OF HOW _____ IT MAY SEEM

March around the city once with all the armed men. Do this for six days. Have seven priests carry trumpets of rams' horns in front of the ark. On the seventh day, march around the city seven times, with the priests blowing the trumpets. When you hear them sound a long blast on the trumpets, have the whole army give a loud shout; then the wall of the city will collapse and the army will go up, everyone straight in. Joshua 6:3-5 (NIV)

Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ. Ephesians 5:21 (NIV)

So Joshua son of Nun called the priests and said to them, "Take up the ark of the covenant of the Lord and have seven priests carry trumpets in front of it." And he ordered the army, "Advance! March around the city, with an armed guard going ahead of the ark of the Lord."

The armed guard marched ahead of the priests who blew the trumpets, and the rear guard followed the ark.

All this time the trumpets were sounding. Joshua 6:6-7, 9 (NIV)

6. USUALLY YOU NEED TO DECLARE _____ BEFORE IT ACTUALLY HAPPENS

The seventh time around, when the priests sounded the trumpet blast, Joshua commanded the army, "Shout! For the Lord has given you the city! When the trumpets sounded, the army shouted, and at the sound of the trumpet, when the men gave a loud shout, the wall collapsed; so everyone charged straight in, and they took the city. Joshua 6:16, 20 (NIV)

7. DON'T MESS IT UP BY _____ STUFF GOD SAYS NOT TO _____

But keep away from the devoted things, so that you will not bring about your own destruction by taking any of them. Otherwise you will make the camp of Israel liable to destruction and bring trouble on it.
