

As Jesus was leaving the temple, one of his disciples said to him, "Look, Teacher! What massive stones! What magnificent buildings!" "Do you see all these great buildings?" replied Jesus. "Not one stone here will be left on another; every one will be thrown down." WHAT DOES JESUS SAY TO HIS DISCIPLES ABOUT THE END TIMES?

1. WE _____ THERE YET

Jesus said to them: "Watch out that no one deceives you. Many will come in my name, claiming, 'I am he,' and will deceive many. When you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be alarmed. Such things must happen, but the end is still to come. Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be earthquakes in various places, and famines. These are the beginning of birth pains." **Mark 13:5-8 (NIV)**

2. THERE ARE SOME _____ TIMES AHEAD FOR YOU

You must be on your guard. You will be handed over to the local councils and flogged in the synagogues. On account of me you will stand before governors and kings as witnesses to them. **Mark 13:9 (NIV)**

And the gospel must first be preached to all nations. **Mark 13:10 (NIV)**

Two parallel truths:

1. God loves you and is for you
2. God is more concerned for his kingdom than he is for your current comfort

3. THERE ARE SOME REALLY _____ TIMES FOR EVERYBODY ON THE HORIZON

When you see "the abomination that causes desolation" standing where it does not belong—let the reader understand—then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. **Mark 13:14 (NIV)**

He will confirm a covenant with many for one 'seven.' In the middle of the 'seven' he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And at the temple he will set up an abomination that causes desolation, until the end that is decreed is poured out on him. **Daniel 9:27 (NIV)**

4. KEEP YOUR HEAD _____, BECAUSE I'M _____ IN THE _____

... 'the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from the sky, and the heavenly bodies will be shaken.' "At that time people will see the Son of Man coming in clouds with great power and glory. And he will send his angels and gather his elect from the four winds, from the ends of the earth to the ends of the heavens." **Mark 13:24-27 (NIV)**

But about that day or hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. **Mark 13:32 (NIV)**

Be on guard! Be alert! You do not know when that time will come. It's like a man going away: He leaves his house and puts his servants in charge, each with their assigned task, and tells the one at the door to keep watch. Therefore keep watch because you do not know when the owner of the house will come back—whether in the evening, or at midnight, or when the rooster crows, or at dawn. If he comes suddenly, do not let him find you sleeping. What I say to you, I say to everyone: 'Watch!' **Mark 13:33-37 (NIV)**

3. ARE YOU _____?

And do this, understanding the present time: The hour has already come for you to wake up from your slumber, because our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed. The night is nearly over; the day is almost here. So let us put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light. Let us behave decently, as in the daytime, not in carousing and drunkenness, not in sexual immorality and debauchery, not in dissension and jealousy. Rather, clothe yourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ, and do not think about how to gratify the desires of the flesh. **Romans 13:11-14 (NIV)**
