Reflect

Throughout this series, we've been learning that generosity is not something that God wants from us, but rather something that he wants for us. This week, Pastor Josh Surratt taught us about the limitations that debt can place on our lives, temptations we face with money and the Biblical perspective on money.

Pastor Josh taught us about how money can serve us as we serve God.

1. Money buys us time.
2. Money buys us options.
3. Money allows us to be a blessing to others as God leads.
