Life Group Questions: Being Single

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Read

1 Corinthians 7:25-38

Reflect

Our culture's views of singleness and marriage have dramatically changed over the last 50 years. Fewer people are getting married and those that do tend to wait longer to do so. This week we want to try to find out: How can we serve God and honor him during the season of singleness?

Pastor Greg gave us four things to remember when we're single:

1. Be pure
 - a. Staying pure while we're single can be a huge challenge. What safeguards are in place for you in this area? How can we encourage our single friends in this?
2. Be wise
 - a. Paul encouraged the Corinthians to be wise in their approach to relationships. What is God saying to you in this season of your life? How much time do you spend seeking guidance from God about your relationships? How often do you seek guidance from godly friends?
3. Be radically devoted
 - a. In 1 Corinthians 7:32-34 Paul points out that single people have the potential to live their lives for God in a way that married people often cannot. How can we devote our single years to God? How can we encourage our single friends in this?
4. Be considerate
 - a. When it comes to your relationships, are you living in a way that is considerate to those around you? Is there anyone you might be leading on? Is there a decision you've been putting off that actually affects another person?
