Acts 1:4-8; 2:1-4

Reflect

One of the most shocking things Jesus told his followers was that he had to leave them. They didn't understand what he meant and it made them nervous. But Jesus explained that his departure would be marked by the arrival of another; the Holy Spirit. We all rely on the Holy Spirit every day, whether we know if or not.

Pastor Greg outlined seven moments when we will need the Holy Spirit:

1. When you are confused he will guide you
2. When you are hurting he will comfort you
3. When you are powerless he will empower you
4. When you are forgetful he will remind you
5. When you are speechless he will speak through you
6. When you are sinful he will correct you
7. When you are empty he will fill you
