1 Corinthians 9:24-27

Reflect

There are many idols in this world but by far the most attractive for us, in our culture and time, is comfort. We love comfort and once we have it we guard it zealously. One of the reasons Christianity is so challenging is it calls us to leave comfort behind, to live in ways that require sacrifice. How has your faith challenged you recently?

Pastor Josh Walters gave us three reasons to get off our tubes:

1. He came
 - a. Think and reflect on the example Jesus set by coming to earth. What can we learn about God from the fact that he became one of us? What does Christ's coming tell us about how God sees other people?
2. He sent me
 - a. When Jesus sent his disciples, he did so with words meant for all Christians throughout history. The call to make disciples means that those people will also make disciples, and so on. Do you feel sent by God? Do you live your life with this mission in mind?
3. He's with me
 - a. Do you believe that God is with you wherever you go? It's easy to say we do, but do our lives actually reflect that belief? What are some fears you have that need to be confronted with the promise of Jesus' constant presence?
