#### Read

Revelation 12:11, Luke 8: 39, John 8:1-11

#### Reflect

We all experience circumstances out of our control, but when we choose to accept and give grace, then the finished work of Jesus and the word of our testimony will cause others to rise up as believers.

Grace is an attribute we all experience. Pastor Josh Walters talks about how we can reach people through our willingness to love them rather than judge them.

#### People Will Experience Grace When I...

##### 1. Look Beyond Their Circumstances.

- a. In some circumstances, we feel like we are stranding up for God. What sin of others brings about a righteous anger in you?
- b. God isn't looking for someone else to judge them, he's looking for someone to love them. How can you turn your judgement into love for another person?

##### 2. Get My Hands Dirty

Jesus doesn't condone the woman's sin in John 8, but he reminds the religious leaders of their sin too.

- a. What is stopping you from going all in with a tough situation where you might get caught in the middle?
- b. Who is it that God might be wanting you to get your hands dirty for?

##### 3. Speak To Their Future

God is disciplining you because he loves you.

- a. How have you experienced grace in your own life that can now lead to extending grace to others?

**Respond:** Are you willing to look beyond circumstances, and represent others well, so they can experience the true love of Christ?
