Reading the practical and theological book of Romans can answer these two questions: Is there a God? What does he want from me?

Read: Romans 11:33, Romans 12

HOW WE WORSHIP

1. WE WORSHIP GOD TRULY “THEREFORE”

From him, and to him all things are made... this verse describes the greatness of God.

1. How would you answer the question, “who made God?”
2. What are some differences between the Creator, and creation?

2. REVELATION - A DISCLOSURE FROM GOD TO HUMANKIND OF GOD’S CHARACTER, GOD’S WAYS AND GOD’S WILL.

God has shown himself to us, so that we can perceive him. If he could not have done that, then we could not know him. Why is the most warned sin idolatry?

3. WE WORSHIP GOD HUMBLY “BY THE MERCIES OF GOD”

God did not have to reach down to us. Why do you think God chose to show us mercy?

4. WE WORSHIP GOD HOLISTICALLY “TO PRESENT YOUR BODIES AS A LIVING SACRIFICE”

Your main temptation is not to disobey God. Our main temptation is to limit our obedience to our convenience. How can you surrender wholeheartedly to God, and not just the part that fits your schedule?

5. WE WORSHIP GOD RATIONALLY “BE TRANSFORMED BY THE RENEWAL OF YOUR MIND.”

1. God wants us to give all of ourselves to worship. How do you renew your mind?
2. We are in an internal conversation with ourselves that greatly affects what we do and say. What are you telling yourself about you, and about God? What emotive language are you speaking?

6. WE WORSHIP GOD COMMUNALLY “I APPEAL TO YOU BROTHERS”

If you only worship by yourself, you will not experience the joy God has for you. What steps can you take to ensure that you are in community seeking God together?
