John 16:32-33, 1 Corinthians 15:3-8, Joshua 3:7

Reflect

In a time where attending church looks different, and we are each scattered in our own homes, Jesus' words in John 16:32-33 reminds us that we are not alone. In what ways have you felt God's presence during isolation?

We can take heart/be courageous because:

1. **JESUS HAS GONE BEFORE ME**

- a. How can we be encouraged when we're feeling discouraged?
- b. How can we take heart when the future seems uncertain?

2. **I KNOW GOD WILL USE THIS FOR MY GOOD**

- a. Where have you seen God work things out for your good?
- b. What ways can you step into leadership during crisis to show others that God has good for them?
- c. How can you address the doubt that arises when you can't see the good?

3. **I KNOW I AM NOT ALONE**

- a. Jesus was constantly aware of the unseen presence of God in his life. If we're going to take heart we have to get good at focusing on the unseen. In what ways can you grow your faith when you begin to feel alone?
- b. Who can you call today to lift their spirits and remind them of God's love?
