Reflect

Creating a generational legacy begins when we rely on God's love, and use it to change us on the inside. While we can't change many of our genetic physical features, we can make changes on the inside that will impact the joy and blessings of our children.

2. WHAT NEEDS TO START WITH ME?

- a. What positive attitudes, or behaviors have you inherited that are worth passing down to your children?
- b. What do you want your family to be known for?

3. FROM WHOM AM I TAKING MY CUES AS A DAD?

- a. Who are you learning from?
- b. What is preventing you from showing affection, affirmation, or acceptance to your children?
