*“Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have, I give to you.”  
Then he told the man, “In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk.”* **Acts 3:6 (NIV)**

- **IT IS IMPORTANT TO ASK FOR HELP.**

- **IF PEOPLE WALK WITH YOU, WHERE WILL THEY END UP?**
- **WE NEED TO BE WILLING TO REACH OUT AND HELP EACH OTHER STAND UP**

*Taking him by the right hand, he helped him up.* **Acts 3:7 (NIV)**
