

## **Small Group Questions: Undivided/Walking Humbly with Your God**

### **Read**

Micah 6:8

### **Reflect**

During this series, we have been unpacking Micah 6:8 to discover how we, as Christians, can please God: by acting justly, loving mercy, and walking humbly with Him.

Guest speaker Christine Caine concludes the study by discussing the last command in this verse – to walk humbly with our God – and how obeying it enables us do everything else God asks.

1. How is your walk with God? What can you do to improve it?
2. Being humble is not being insecure. It is knowing who God is and who you are in Him. Also, it's not thinking less of yourself. It is thinking less about yourself.
  - a. Do these explanations differ from how you have thought about humility? Why or why not?
  - b. Knowing these explanations, what step(s) can you take to be humble?
3. At a time when the world seems divided, what can you do to be a part of the solution and not the problem?
4. Do you feel like you're in a "time out" right now? How can you use your gifts and talents for God in this season?
