Reflect:

In this second part of the Royals Series, Pastor Josh Surratt examines King David, a man who knew what it felt like to be overlooked, and the ways in which God chooses people that mankind is prone to overlook.

 - b. How do you feel your heart compares with King David's? King Saul's?
 - c. What convictions might be moving you to be a person of heart?

- 2. JUST BECAUSE YOU ARE NOT VISIBLE IN MAN'S EYES DOESN'T MEAN YOU AREN'T VALUABLE IN GOD'S EYES.**
 - a. How does God contradict mankind's idea of value in the story of King David?
 - b. King David's father didn't value him above his other sons-- how might being overlooked have benefited David?

- 3. BE FAITHFUL IN THE FIELD AND TRUST GOD WITH THE TIMING.**
 - a. What fields has God called you to? In what ways might he be preparing your heart and your talents?
