Reflect

TO FIND HOPE IN AN UNCERTAIN WORLD, WE NEED TO KNOW:

1. GOD WILL NOT GIVE US MORE THAN HE CAN HANDLE

- a. How does Paul's trust in God compare to your trust in him during trials?
- b. Why does God allow us to be in situations that are more than we can handle?
- c. What kind of mindset do we need to have to find hope in overwhelming situations?

2. WE ALL HAVE PAIN, BUT WE DON'T ALL TALK ABOUT IT

- a. How do you think your situation can change when you are open to talking about your pain?
- b. What have you experienced after becoming vulnerable about a situation? Did it affect the way you handle situations now?

3. HOPE GROWS AS SELF-RELIANCE DIES

- a. What must we do to release control of our performance driven lifestyle?
- b. What can happen when we understand our identity in God?
- c. Why do you think God wants us to rely on him for everything?
