Reflect

THE PURSUIT OF HEAVEN

1. STARTS WITH PRAYER

- a. Why do you think we should seek God first before acting on our desires?
- b. How have you seen God honor your pursuit of him?

2. REQUIRES PERSEVERANCE

While we wait on God's timing to receive his outcome for our desires, we must:

- **Use words to describe your feelings.**
 - a. Where can you turn to help you find the right words to describe your feelings?
 - b. If you're not currently using words to describe your feelings, how are you acting on what you're feeling?
- **Be willing to tell those closest to you.**
 - a. Who are you currently sharing your trials with, and do you think you are sharing with the right people?
 - b. If you're not talking with others, what is holding you back from telling someone about your feelings?
 - c. How can you prepare yourself to be a person that others can confide in?
- **Keep going back to God.**
 - a. What small step can you take continually to go after God?
 - b. How can you make space to hear God's response to your prayers?

3. INVOLVES PEOPLE

- a. How might you be able to involve your small group to help you pursue God more?
- b. How can pursuing heaven together reach others for Christ?
