Series Overview

In a world where seeing is believing, we want to help equip students to be able to not only wrestle the questions that they have in their faith, but be able to defend their faith to others who are questioning. We want to get them the knowledge to understand and know why they believe what they believe.

Message Overview

Jesus' claim that He is God means one of three things about Jesus is true. Either he was a liar who made audacious claims that weren't true. Either he was a lunatic who wasn't in his right mind. Or, he is Lord and everything that he said and did was true and proved that.

Small Group Questions

- What's your personal view on Jesus?
- What in your life has shaped your view on Jesus? Do negative or positive events in your life make an impact?
- Why does it matter that Jesus claimed he is the Son of God? (Ref. Jn. 14:6; Jn. 5:24-26)
- Why does it matter that others claimed Jesus is God?
- Why did the religious leaders struggle to believe in Jesus?
- What can we apply to our life from the ministry of Jesus?
- What would people think of the way Jesus did things if he lived now and not 2000 years ago? Would social media play a positive or negative role in that? Explain.

Application

So, who is Jesus? He is God. He is the Savior of the world. He is the Messiah. He is the Creator of the world. He is part of the Trinity. Jesus is who He said He is and accomplished what He said He would accomplish. Because of that we can trust in Him, put our faith in Him, and follow Him.
