This week, we continue our series on the beliefs and values that unite us as a church. Pastor Josh Surratt discusses how vital the Holy Spirit is to our faith.

SEVEN SITUATIONS WHEN YOU ARE GOING TO NEED THE SPIRIT'S HELP

1. When you are confused, he will guide you.

- a. Where do you tend to seek guidance first?
- b. When has the Holy Spirit revealed a truth to you? What did you learn?

2. When you are hurting, he will comfort you.

- a. In what ways has the Holy Spirit comforted you or someone you love?

3. When you are powerless, he empowers us.

- a. What specific tools are we given by the Holy Spirit?
- b. How could you make better use of those tools?

4. When you are forgetful, he will remind you.

- a. What reminders has the Spirit given you to help guide you through difficult situations, or even in daily life? Were they subtle hints or very clear directives?

5. When you are speechless, he will speak for you.

- a. How does it impact you to know that the Holy Spirit intercedes for us in our prayers?

6. When you are sinful, he will correct you.

- a. What is the difference between conviction and condemnation?

7. When you are empty, he will fill you.

- a. How does this aspect of the Holy Spirit correlate to our practice of communion?
