

## **Small Group Questions: Expecting A Miracle**

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### **Read**

Mark 6: 50-52, Luke 9: 12, Mark 6:38-41, John 6: 26-34

### **Reflect**

Jesus performed many miracles in front of his disciples, but even after just participating in the feeding of the 5,000, they were terrified when they saw Jesus walking on water toward them. Their hearts had become hardened, as they did not fully understand and know the God of miracles.

Pastor Josh Walters discusses three ways that we can maintain a heart of compassion.

## **I CAN MAINTAIN A HEART OF COMPASSION WHEN I...**

### **1. Look at normal needs with supernatural eyes.**

### **2. Expect God to use what is in my hands.**

- a. How can you point people to Jesus through serving others?
- b. What is something you already do regularly that could be used to make a kingdom impact?
