Acts 9:3-9

Reflect

For the last few weeks, we have been in a series called “Walking Away from Jesus,” and we have been talking about people whose lives have been changed as a result of an encounter with Jesus. In this message, Pastor Adam Martin uses the story of Paul on the road to Damascus to show how meeting Jesus causes people to see things differently.

When we encounter Jesus...

- 1. We walk away with a clearer perspective of who God is.**
 - a. Have you ever wondered about how God feels about something?
 - b. How does Jesus’s life and example tell you God feels about this thing?
- 2. We walk away with a clearer perspective of who we are.**
 - a. What is something you have trouble understanding about God?
 - b. How might submitting to Him / bowing to Him in humility help you understand?
- 3. We will also begin to see our challenges more clearly.**
 - a. What challenges are you currently facing?
 - b. How might God be using them to draw you closer to Jesus?
 - c. How has God used your past challenges to draw you closer?
- 4. We walk away seeing our purpose more clearly.**
 - a. Has God ever humbled you? What happened as a result?
 - b. Has God ever used to you reach or serve someone you had a bias against? If so, how?
