### **Read**

Genesis 2:24, Romans 8:29, John 1:12-13, Psalm 133:1

### **Reflect**

We are created to be a part of God's family. It's his ultimate expression of love for us. We can choose to join his family, but we can't choose the other members. When we learn to see the privilege of being in God's family, even in the mess, we'll learn how to live together the way he intended.

Using the series, The Mandalorian, Pastor Jack Hoey discusses the powerful connection to Christ when we decide to love the people we didn't choose.

#### **3. Learn to accept help from others**

- a. Why do you think it is hard for you to accept or ask for help from others?
- b. What are some obstacles to receiving help in your life?
- c. Can you think of a time when you had to rely on others for help? Describe that experience.
