Reflect

Oftentimes, during conflict, our first instinct is to become prideful. But, when we humble ourselves and begin to serve others, God's peace enters and relationships are mended.

Pastor Tim Lindsay discusses Jesus' humility and gives us three ways that God blesses us when we serve others.

1. When you serve someone, God gives you his favor

1. Think of a time when you chose to serve someone. What blessing came from that experience?
2. How have you seen a relationship change because you decided to serve another person?

2. When you serve someone, God gives you purpose

1. How have you experienced true fulfillment by humbling yourself to serve others?
2. Have you discovered your purpose through serving others? Tell your small group about that experience.

3. When you serve someone, God breaks the power of the enemy over you

1. What steps can you take to become humble in a difficult relationship?
2. Why do you think it was important for Jesus to ask Peter three times "Do you love me?"
3. What does Jesus' response to Peter's "yes" mean for you?

Respond: Where is God leading you? How can your small group support you?
