1. MINIMIZE EXPOSURE TO TOXIC FRIENDS

- **Arguing** friends

Proverbs 26:17 (NIV)

- **Gossiping** friends

A gossip betrays a confidence, but a trustworthy person keeps a secret.
Proverbs 11:13 (NIV)

A perverse person stirs up conflict, and a gossip separates close friends.
Proverbs 16:28 (NIV)

- **Flattering** friends

Those who flatter their neighbors are spreading nets for their feet.
Proverbs 29:5 (NIV)

- **Loose-tempered** friends

Don't hang out with angry people; don't keep company with hotheads; Bad temper is contagious— don't get infected.
Proverbs 22:24-25 (MSG)
