Reflect

In this message, Pastor Josh Surratt tackles the tough question of sexuality. He discusses premarital sex, adultery, pornography, lust, rape, sex trafficking, and LGBTQ+ issues.

- c. How can we pray specifically for you? Are there any areas in which you would like the group to hold you accountable?
