Reflect

Pastor Greg discusses what God says about choosing life and offers us three truths to remember no matter where you fall on the issue.

1. God loves everybody.

- a. When someone disagrees with you on important issues, how hard is it to remember that God loves them, too? How could remembering this impact how you interact with them?
- b. In what ways can you show love without conveying approval?
- c. Where are you finding your truth? How anchored in God's Word is it?

2. God chooses when life begins.

- a. Do you believe that all lives are created by God and every one matters? How does this impact your views on life?
- b. How can you help protect the weak and vulnerable?
- c. How can we prevent judging the value of another person or child?

3. Our tone matters.

- a. How do you tend to speak to and treat people who disagree with you?
 - i. How hard is it to listen to them if they don't completely agree with you?
- b. Challenge: Invite someone you're having a problem with to get coffee. Talk about what you agree on, and work from there.
- c. How have you seen the Holy Spirit change hearts on this issue of life?
- d. Regardless of position on the issue, it is for most women, an experience they would prefer never to go through. How can you be there for someone who has personal experience with this difficult issue?
