1. How Should We Pray?

2. Areas We Should Pray Over

- a. Read 1 Chronicles 20:10-13 – What does this verse teach us about praying for resources? As a group, pray a prayer of resource.
- b. Read Psalm 51:10-12 – What does this verse teach us about alignment? As a group, pray a prayer of alignment.
- c. Read James 5:13-16 – What does this verse teach us about praying for healing? As a group, pray a prayer of healing.
- d. Read Luke 11:5-13 – What does this verse teach us about praying with shameless audacity? As a group, pray a prayer that you might be more open with God in your prayer life.
