Reflect

This weekend, Seacoast Church celebrated the next generation by recognizing youth and volunteers in our Kidscoast and Custom environments. We can all have an amazing influence on our children, by looking for ways to fight for the hearts of young people.

Pastor Jon Hohm outlined ways we can identify those areas to make a positive impact on the next generation.

A divided world needs a united church.

- What division in the world today breaks your heart?
- How can the church be different?

There is no success without a successor. True success is measured by succession.

- Pastor Jon gives many examples from the Bible of leaders succeeding leaders. What good – or bad – examples of succession to we see in today's world?
- How are you working to raise up people who will succeed you spiritually? Or if you aren't currently, how can you?

1. Keep your eyes open.

- a. How do you currently pour into young people?
- b. What opportunities are around you that you might be missing?

2. Hold tight to your convictions.

- a. What fears might be holding you back from getting involved in a young person's life?

3. Love without stopping.

Pastor Jon encourages us to pray, take the first step, and then point them to Jesus.

- a. How can you make space to pray for the next generation? Who specifically will you commit to praying for?
- b. What first step can you take this week?
- c. In what ways can we all try to point young people to Jesus?
