Matthew 7:15-20; 21-23; Ezekiel 13:1-2; John 15:9-11

Reflect

Jesus warned the crowds. He said, “Watch out for false prophets. They come in sheep’s clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves.” Our culture readily displays bad fruit as well as good fruit. How can we identify the difference?

Pastor Joel Delph highlights the following:

- 1. False prophets have always been an issue. Good teaching produces good fruit, and bad teaching produces bad fruit.**
 - a. Discuss false prophets and identify them in today’s culture. Can you give an example of a ferocious wolf and warning signs?
 - b. Why do you place the Bible as the front page of truth?
 - c. Consider your circle of friends. Where did you meet them and how does that relate to their influence on you?
- 2. Consistency speaks, God guarantees correction, and actions mean more than intent.**
 - a. How do you show that you are a Christian?
 - b. Discuss a time when you asked God for help, and in the process you helped someone else.
 - c. What Christian actions did you complete last week? If you can’t recall any, then make a plan for the upcoming week.
- 3. God sees our heart.**
 - a. Discuss your beliefs and how they impact your daily life.
 - b. We fall many times. How often do you show obedience and study God’s word?
 - c. How can you express your appreciation to God through your actions?
 - d. Read and discuss the lyrics of the hymn “What a Friend We Have In Jesus.”
