

Small Group Questions: Get in Position

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Read

Acts 8:26-40

Reflect

When we identify as something other than Christian, we are depriving ourselves of being really powerful people and are left paralyzed rather than utilized. God has given us power to get in position to use it here on earth within our relationships, workplace, and community. When God places you somewhere, the assignment is to be a light to people. As Phillip did, we must keep our eyes focused on the purpose of the Gospel and God will continue to use us to display his goodness to others.

Pastor Joel Delph uses scripture to guide us into believing we have the power of Christ living in us. When we utilize this power, we are fulfilling the assignments God has placed before us, helping further the Kingdom of God.

1. When God tells you where, look for who

- a. How can you use your current position (work, community, family, etc) to live out God's purpose for you?
- b. Who in your daily life is someone you can be a light to? And what does that look like?

2. There is always common ground at the cross

- a. What barriers do you feel keep you from being intentional with others?
 - i. What is hindering you from believing you were created for this moment in life?
- b. If there is someone in your life that you struggle to be intentional with, how can you go about changing this?

3. Tell the good news of Jesus

- a. Have you told your full testimony recently? If not, would you be willing to share with your small group today?

4. We've all been on the journey for what's missing

- a. What in your life are you currently searching for?
 - i. Give an example of when you sought something of this world
 - ii. Give an example of God meeting you while on that journey

5. Invite others into your search for understanding

- a. What are you currently struggling to understand?
- b. How can you invite your small group into the entirety of that struggle?

6. Let me tell you the good news

- a. How can your small group encourage you while you're in your lowest of lows to walk in the power that you were intended to receive?

Respond: Where is God leading you? How can your small group support you?
