Reflect

God is the restorer of things that are broken, but oftentimes, we walk around unwilling to admit that we need him to take us from functioning to flourishing. When we are brave enough to confess that we need to align our life with God, he will change the trajectory of our lives. Jesus encourages us to learn from him and seek rest as well as replenishment.

Guest speaker, Pastor Charlotte Gambill highlights how we can choose to follow Jesus's example and to leave a legacy for generation.

1. Priority: Choose mission over position

- a. What are you placing above of the mission?
- b. Read and discuss the meaning of Galatians 5:25.
Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.
- c. When have you taken position as the "arm holder," and what did that teach you about God's mission?

2. Priority: Choose Motivation over expectation

- a. Our world today is recognition driven and agenda driven. How have you seen that in those around you, and in your own life? What has it taught you about your priorities?
- b. Talk about your plans for Thanksgiving and your motives for your plans. How can you celebrate Thanksgiving with love and compassion for others?

3. Priority: Choose legacy over temporary

- a. How can you choose legacy over temporary in your family? Who do you need to contact and share the Word of God?
- b. How can you pour into the next generation?
- c. Do you know a real life hero? Talk about the person and his/her legacy.

Respond: Where is God leading you? How can your small group support you?
