Reflect

Solomon, son of David, wrote Proverbs to his descendants and the Israelites. He wanted to give others instruction and wisdom for living. This book of the Bible provides a powerful path of life that includes acceptance of God's word and pursuit of it. What is your favorite Proverb? Why?

1. The Price of Guidance

- c. Describe one of your trusted advisors and the help he/she has given you.

3. The Purpose of Guidance

- a. How is the book of Proverbs applicable today?
- b. How do you allow God to guide you?
- c. Describe your relationship with God. How can you improve it?
