Reflect

In 1992, Gary Chapman published his book, *The Five Love Languages*, to teach people to show love to their partners in the way the other person can best receive it. One of the ways to love someone is by giving gifts. Giving gifts is not only a way to love your spouse; it's a way to love God.

Gifts That Please God

1. The heart of the giver

- a. What is the condition of your heart? Is it generous and grateful?
- b. How can you practice more generosity in your life?
- c. What has God done for you?
- d. What are you thankful for?
- e. How can you grow in generosity and gratitude?

2. The priority of the gift

- a. How can you give in such a way to put God first?
- b. What can you do to make giving to God a higher priority?
- c. How has God opened up the floodgates in your life as promised in Malachi 3:10-12?

3. The faith required to give it

- a. Why does God want what's first in our lives?
- b. How does giving God the first and best show your faith?

Respond: Where is God leading you? How can your small group support you?
