Reflect

The movie, Jesus Revolution, tells the story of a movement that occurred in the late 1960s, and early 1970s when the views of a pastor of a dying church, and a generation searching for God collide. Their acceptance of each other brought thousands of people to hear about and accept Jesus.

Pastor Greg Surratt highlights three reasons the Jesus Revolution was so prominent to Christianity.

1. Everyone is searching for something.

- a. Where might you be searching for something, but finding all the wrong answers?
- b. What do you find yourself continuously searching for in your own life?
- c. Why do you think everyone is searching for something? What's the common theme?

2. Everyone is searching for something, and Jesus is that something.

- a. If Jesus is who he said he is, what are you still searching for?
- b. In what ways has finding Jesus made you stop searching for something?
- c. Why do you think the generation during the Jesus Revolution was so eager to learn about Jesus rather than continuing their search for something else?

3. Keep Jesus The Main Thing

- a. In what areas of your life do you hide Jesus from others?
- b. How have you seen leaders make it about themselves? How did it effect those around them?
- c. How can you make Jesus the main thing in your own life?
- d. When have you had the opportunity to start over with Jesus as the main thing?
