- ii. How can you try to leverage it rather than fighting against it?

c. I can learn from my past without letting it define me.

i. What step do you need to take to learn from and be freed from your past?

d. I can anchor myself in the unchanging truth of God's word and his character.

i. Do you ever feel like God's commands are burdensome? Why or why not?

e. I can accept responsibility for my life.

 - 1. What do you need to change about how you see yourself?
- ii. By changing how I see my circumstances.
 - 1. What circumstances do you need to see differently?

f. I can only fulfill God's mission with God's help.

i. How can you depend on God rather than trying to do life by yourself?
