ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, slip a note of encouragement in their school bag or lunch. (And if going to school isn't a part of your family's routine right now, put the note in their room or bathroom.)



Meal Time

At a meal, have everyone at the table answer this question: "What are some ways you use your imagination when playing or reading?"



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "Describe what you think would be the perfect day. What would you do? Where would you go? What would you eat? Who would you want to spend time with?"



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "God, thank You that you are real and You created us with imagination. Help us to use our imagination to honor You."
