- FALL IN LOVE WITH JESUS
- SEE THE NEED
- LISTEN TO THEIR STORY
- SHARE WHAT HE'S DONE

FALL IN LOVE WITH JESUS: WE TALK ABOUT WHAT WE LOVE [WOMAN AT THE WELL: JOHN 4:1-26]

REMEMBER HOW HIS LOVE CHANGED YOU

- Take a look at the story of the Samaritan Woman in John 4. How did Jesus pursue the Samaritan woman?
- How has your relationship with Jesus changed you?

HIS FREEDOM PUSHES US PAST OUR FEARS

- What insecurities did the Samaritan Woman push through to share her encounter with Jesus?
- What fears do you have when you think about sharing your faith?

SEE THE NEED [PARABLE OF THE GOOD SAMARITAN: LUKE 10:25-37]

ALLOW YOUR HEART TO BE BROKEN

- Take a look at the parable of the Good Samaritan: How was the Samaritan's response to the beaten man different from everyone else (see verse 33)?
- What makes you blind to the hurt of those around you?

DO WHAT YOU CAN TO SERVE

- The good samaritan was prepared to respond to the need of the beaten man: How can you prepare yourself for the hurt of those you encounter?

Sharing Your Faith Discussion Questions



- How do you know what problems you can help & when to take a hurting person to a place of healing?

LISTEN TO THEIR STORY [PHILIP & THE ETHIOPIAN EUNUCH ACTS 8:26-40]

YOUR SUPERPOWER IS IN THEIR EARS

- What did Philip do when God told him to go near the chariot?
- Share a time in your life when you felt heard: how did that impact you?

MEET THEM IN THEIR STRUGGLE

- The Eunuch was on a pilgrimage to find God, but instead of getting the Gospel in the temple in Jerusalem, God sent a man to him on his journey home: Share a time when God sent someone to help you in an unlikely place?
- How could God be sending you in unlikely places to share His love?

SHARE WHAT HE'S DONE [PETER AT PENTECOST ACTS 2 & ROMANS 10]

YOUR STORY HAS POWER

- Take 30 seconds and share How God has worked in your life- take a moment to encourage each other in the power of your story.

FAITH IN JESUS IS IGNITED IN A SPECIFIC MOMENT

- Why is confessing with your mouth important in our relationship with Christ

Challenge: text one person right now and encourage them
