Reflect

To better understand our own stories, we must become self-aware. In the process though, our culture has become self-focused. But, when we see how God continually pursues us, we begin to put others first, showing them that God truly cares about them too.

Pastor Adam Martin highlights ways we can see God's example and how we can extend his love to others:

1. God has pursued us.

- a. When has God reached out to you? Did you respond?
- b. How do you "...walk faithfully with God"? (Genesis 5:22)
- c. How does today's culture block your relationship with God?

2. God put our needs first.

- a. Why did God clothe Adam and Eve?
- b. Describe a time that you felt God put your needs first.
- c. When have you doubted your trust in God? Why?

3. God is calling us to put others first.

- a. Talk about a recent situation that you put someone else's needs ahead of your own desires.
- b. Describe a time in your life when God's blessings to you, flowed through you to reach someone else.
- c. Why did the worship team choose the song "Pour Me Out" to accompany this message?
- d. Can you see someone's potential and show up for that person? Who do you know, needs an invitation to attend church?

Respond: Where is God leading you? How can your small group support you?
