Reflect:

1. The Holy Spirit helps us see God as he is.

- b. How has the Holy Spirit helped you see God as he is?
- c. In what ways have you seen “the truth” pursuing you?
- d. What have you learned about Jesus with the help of the Holy Spirit?

2. The Holy Spirit helps us see others as they are.

- a. What does it mean to become children of God?
- b. How has the Holy Spirit become a light to guide relationships with others who are not “part of your family?”
- c. What has held you back from inviting others to God’s table?

3. The Holy Spirit helps us see ourselves as we are.

- a. Why have you felt that God’s table is for others, but not for yourself?
- b. What has taking a seat at God’s table cost you?
- c. How have you made God the authority of your life? How has that changed the way you live?
