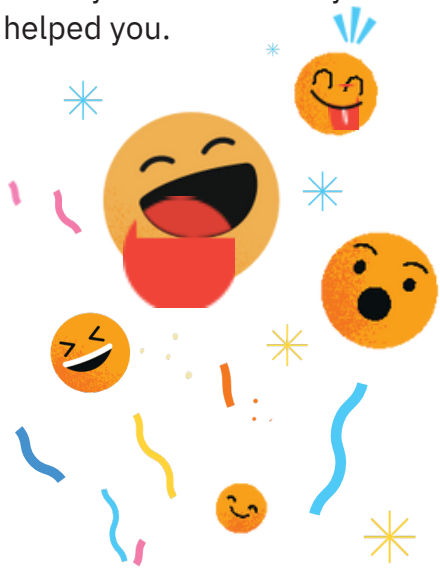

Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, thank them for something they do on a regular basis. Maybe it's a chore that is expected of them or something you ask of them on a regular basis.



Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: “Who is someone you need to thank for something they have done to help you—whether they realize it or not?”



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: “What is something nice or helpful that someone has done for you lately?”



Bed Time

Pray for each other: “God, help us to live a life of gratitude, always conscious of the ways those around have helped us and letting them know how much we appreciate it.”
