Reflect

The faithfulness of God that we get to experience today is because of the vision for the church over the past 35 years. As Proverbs 29:18 tells us, it's important to set a vision for our lives because without vision, people perish. What's your vision for your life?

What Does God Want To Do In You?

1. Give your life to Jesus

- c. Do you have a vision of your role at Seacoast? Share your thoughts and plans.

2. Be made new by Jesus

- a. How can you give up things that don't matter and work toward changing your focus? What is your next step toward the focus adjustment?
- b. In what ways do you need to improve your ability to imitate Jesus?
- c. How has Jesus set you free from challenges in your life?

3. Become like Jesus

- a. What character trait or attitude of Jesus do you find most appealing? How can you strive to improve this trait or attitude in your own life?
- b. Why do you believe we should be humble when helping others?
- c. What part of your life doesn't look like Jesus right now?

4. Get on mission with Jesus

- a. Peter and Andrew left their nets and followed Christ. Describe a time when you had an opportunity to follow Christ. Why or why didn't you move forward?
- b. Review and discuss the Seacoast legacy goals. What do you find exciting about Seacoast music, campus expansion, global missions, and debt repayment?
