Reflect

- b. Why was going to show the priest important?
- c. What is an area of your life in which you sense you need to obey God, but you're struggling?

3. With gratitude

- a. Of the ten lepers who are healed, who returns to thank Jesus?
 - i. Why might this be somewhat of a surprise?
 - ii. When you receive a blessing, on a scale of 1 to 10, how good are you at remaining present and showing gratitude rather than already thinking past it to the next thing?
